- Referred to as Judah
- ●Began in 931 B.C.
- First ruler was Rehoboam
- Last ruler was Zedekiah
- Total number of rulers: twenty
- Eight were saved
- Consisted of two tribes
- Capital was Jerusalem
- Captured by the Babylonians in 606 B.C
- Three separate returns from captivity
- •Lasted 325 years: 931-606 B.C.






- Began in 931 B.C.
- First ruler was Jeroboam
- Last ruler was Hoshea
- Total number of rulers: nineteen
- Not one was saved
- Consisted of ten tribes
- Capital was Samaria
- Captured by the Assyrians in 721 B.C.
- No return from captivity
- Lasted 210 years: 931—721 B.C.
